

**CONGREGATIONAL MEETING
OLD STONE PRESBYTERIAN CHURCH
SUNDAY, APRIL 10, 2022**

The Session of the Old Stone Presbyterian Church called a Congregational Meeting to be held following morning worship service on Sunday, April 10, 2022. The purpose of the meeting was to elect a PNC (Pastor Nominating Committee). Rev. Jeff Binder, Interim Pastor, declared that a quorum was in attendance, and opened the meeting in prayer. Rev. Binder informed those in attendance that the process for the church to arrive at this point has been happening over the last few months. In October, Rev. Binder arrived as the Interim Pastor and began working with the Session on compiling the Mission Study, which is required by the Presbytery. Upon completion, the study was submitted and approved by the Presbytery's Committee on Ministry. The Nominating Committee was tasked with the responsibility of identifying individuals to serve on the PNC. Once these individuals were identified and their names were presented to the Session, there was discussion that there was not a youth selected. The Session, along with Educator, Amy Kesterson, realized that even though there is no youth on the PNC, their committee will be proactive in listening to the youth and taking into consideration their thoughts.

Marcia Leitch, a member of the Nominating Committee, presented the names of the following individuals to serve on the PNC: Leslie Bicksler, Amy Brown, Becky Kelso, Jason Long and Jim Rowe, who serve as Moderator of the PNC. Rev. Binder then opened the floor for nominations, stating that if there are nominations voting will go from a voice vote to a written vote, with the five individuals receiving the most votes serving on the committee. There were no nominations from the floor. Rev. Binder then asked for the slate to be affirmed with a voice vote – with the slate being APPROVED. The PNC will begin their work with training being provided by the Presbytery and then will work to complete the M.I.F. (Ministry Information Form) which will be submitted and posted on the PC(USA) Leadership Connection.

Rev. Binder opened the floor to any questions pertaining to the process moving forward. Being none, the meeting was closed with prayer by Rev. Binder.
