Return to In-Person Worship July 8, 2021 Update

As we are continuing hybrid worship, both live-streaming and also welcoming those who feel comfortable worshiping in-person, we want to stress that there is not one answer that is right for every person or every situation—it is a choice you must make based on health considerations, your personal preference, and your willingness to follow these guidelines.

Before You Attend

Determine whether you or any member of your immediate household (vaccinated or not vaccinated) has any symptoms that could be connected to Covid-19. If you have any of these symptoms, please worship from home. We are counting on everyone to accept their own responsibility to determine if they could be contagious.

The Service

Please refer to the CDC for guidelines regarding public gatherings as it applies to your personal level of risk. So that you may make an informed decision about whether to join us for in-person worship, please note below what a "fully, In-person Worship" means at this time.

Doors Open- 10:30 A.M.

Windows- The Sanctuary windows will be open before, during and after the service, so dress accordingly. It can still be chilly some summer mornings.

Seating of Congregation- Seating in the sanctuary is no longer limited to a specific number of people. It is possible in the summer months that there will be ample room to social distance yourself and family from other attendees but not guaranteed. The Balcony is also open for seating.

Singing by the congregation- Singing of the hymns by the congregation is permitted.

Masks- Masks are not required for those who are vaccinated. Respectfully request that you follow CDC guidelines for those unvaccinated in your household.

Communion- Communion will continue with a prepackaged serving that you pick up with your bulletin in the narthex. You may partake of the juice and bread with the congregation during that portion of the service. Once the prepackaged supply is exhausted, we will return to passed bread and juice.

Offertory- The collection of your tithes and offerings will be collected during the service by ushers with the offertory box.

Children- Respectfully request that you follow CDC Guidelines for unvaccinated children.
