Session Highlights - Stated Session Meeting (Wednesday, July 27, 2022):

The Session met for their Stated Session meeting on Wednesday, July 27. In attendance were: Moderator, Rev. Jeff Binder; Clerk, Nancy Smallenberger; Educator/Program Coordinator, Amy Kesterson; and Ruling Elders: Jennifer Runyon, Townley Hamilton, Stuart Brown, Sara Irons, Karen Leland and Jim Coleman. Rev. Binder welcomed three guests: Roger Wolfe, Rev. Cameron Harkness and Suzanne Snyder.

Rev. Binder welcomed Roger Wolfe to the meeting, stating that Mr. Wolfe is desiring to join the membership of Old Stone, by letter of transfer. Following a time of introductions, a motion was made, seconded and APPROVED to accept Mr. Wolfe into the membership of OSPC. Rev. Harkness and Suzanne Snyder were in attendance to give the Session an update on the Bereavement group that has been meeting at the church. Currently, twelve individuals have participated. Rev. Harkness and Rev. Hughes will be leading another session, 6-weeks, beginning soon. Those who have participated feel that this is a program that should be built on.

Minutes were presented for approval, including:

- June 22 Stated meeting; and
- July 13 Called/Special meeting, to approve the M.I.F. (Ministry Information Form) that had been completed by the Pastor Nominating Committee

Session heard or reviewed reports from the following committees:

The following action items, requiring Session approval, were presented and approved:

- The Fellowship committee requested additional funds, over and above their committee budget, to help with expenses for the church picnic APPROVED.
- The Property committee presented the updated Room Reservation policy for approval, which was APPROVED and will be included in the Manual of Operations.

Pastor's Report was presented by Pastor Jeff, which included:

- The Stewardship committee has talked with the Trustees concerning the management of the insurance umbrella for the church, with the Trustees agreeing to serve as managers. The Session APPROVED.
- The recently updated Manual of Operations was APPROVED, with the addition of the bullet point pertaining to the Trustees managing the church's insurance.
- Pastoral care updates
- As a part of the transitional conversation, he urged Elders to become familiar with the portion of the Manual of Operations pertaining to the responsibilities of Session members.
- Pastor Jeff expressed his thanks to the Session for the time to attend Part II of his Interim Training that he recently attended.

"Hello all,

I have been remiss in bringing our Tordai Ministries Fund reports up to date. Below you will see the fund information and balances for May, June, and July. We have \$ 1508.30 left in the Ukrainian Support line of this account and \$202.83 left in what I am going to start calling Youth Programs. Arpi and Zsofi decided not to accept any funds from the Scholarship line for Akos and to use those for Youth Programs in their church. As you know if you see their Facebook page, they have had a busy summer!

This is an incredible mission to the people of Romania and now to the people of Ukraine. Funds go directly to the programs with no overhead expenses.
