

PASTOR'S REPORT - Pastor Julie

- Pastoral Care visits she had recently made.
- The Lenten Bible study has ended. Hopefully a new study/discussion group will be planned to begin sometime in May.
- The Grief Group is continuing to meet, with a completion date in May.
- Maundy Thursday worship service will be held on Thursday, March 25, beginning at 6:00 p.m. and lasting approximately 30 minutes.
- The End-of-Year S.T.A.I.R. party was a huge success. Pastor Julie thanked the members of Session who had attended.
- Plans are continuing to start a Book Club that will meet on Wednesday's at noon with those attending to bring a "Brown Bag Lunch".
- Pastor Julie announced that she and Ann Walker are working on plans for a "Presbyterian Heritage Tour" to Scotland in 2025. More information to come.

There were no committee reports presented that required Session action. The Care committee had included a printed report in the packet and financial reports had be included in the packet by the treasurer.

OLD BUSINESS:

• Ratifying an email vote – An email had been received from Brennan Wood on behalf of the Greenbrier Valley Chorale, requesting the use of Fellowship Hall for a rehearsal on Tuesday, March 5, 2024, from 7:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. Pastor Julie had sent the request via email to Session members for their approval. The vote, by email, was to approve the request. A motion was made and seconded to ratify that vote; the motion was APPROVED.

NEW BUSINESS:

- Debbie Taylor, coordinator for the S.T.A.I.R. program, thanked those who had attended and helped with the End-of-Year Party. The students who had participated in this year's program were invited to attend next year's LOGO program.
- Pastor Julie encouraged each committee to continue thinking on "community" both inside and outside the church building.
- The Fellowship and Care committees will be sponsoring a Hot Dog Luncheon following the morning worship service on Sunday, April 21, in honor of LOGO and Youth Sunday. All are encouraged to attend and if they wish to bring either a side dish or dessert to add to the luncheon.
- A Building Use Request was received from Community in Schools to hold a Board meeting in the Activity Room on Thursday, March 21, 2024, from 10: 00 a.m. to 11:30 a.m. A motion was made, seconded to approve the request; motion was APPROVED.
- Jen Runyon, moderator of the Outreach Committee, made a request/motion to attend a motion that had previously been approved by Session, concerning the make-up of the standing Fife Scholarship Committee. The previously approved motion was that members of the committee be: current moderator of the Outreach committee: Amy Ahern and Nancy Smallenberger. Outreach (if there is one), along with Amy Ahern and Nancy Smallenberger." This comes as a motion from committee so no second is needed; motion was APPROVED.

There being no other business that required Session action, the meeting was adjourned and closed with prayer by Pastor Julie.

Scam Emails/Phone Calls Reminder:

This is a reminder to be diligent and watch out for scammers pretending to be staff of Old Stone. We've already had reported instances this year of a scammer sending fake text messages to our church members pretending to be Rev. Julie. We ask that you reach out to us if you receive any texts, emails, or phone calls pretending to be a staff member so that we can notify church members when this is happening.

If you receive an email, text, or phone call and you aren't sure if it is legitimately from a staff

member, please call the church office at (304) 645-2676 to find out. Do NOT reply to the person's text, email, or phone call. We want everyone to be safe and not fall victim to these types of scams. Just as a reminder, we will NEVER reach out to you asking you to purchase gift cards, request any type of monetary exchange, or request personal information, so you can be sure it is a scam if you are asked for any of these things.

While there is no way for us to prevent this from happening 100%, we are taking additional steps to try to reduce the likelihood of this happening in the future.

In the meantime, Rev. Julie has recommended that you report and then block the phone number that sent you the scam text. You can report the text by forwarding the message to 7726. After you block the number, you shouldn't receive any more scam texts from that phone number.

Phishing Reminder from the Presbytery of WV:

PRESBYTERY of West Virginia

A number of people have shared that they received emails this morning from "Rev. Maureen Wright" asking that you return a text sent to you. These emails are a scam. Maureen Wright is a ruling elder not a reverend, and the email is from "organizationmission@gmail.com." All staff emails remain the same. Please delete any email coming from this address, do not give any personal information in response to this, and do not purchase or send money to anyone. Presbytery staff will never randomly ask for personal information or request that you purchase items or send money. If you have any questions, please contact the office.
